3 DESCRIPTIONS

The RS6332P products offer low voltage operation and rail-to-rail input and output, as well as excellent speed/power consumption ratio, providing an excellent bandwidth (1.4MHz) and slew rate of 0.5V/us. The op-amps are unity gain stable and feature an ultra-low input bias current.

The devices are ideal for sensor interfaces, active filters, and portable applications. The RS6332P operational amplifiers are specified at the full temperature range of -40°C to 125°C under single or dual power supplies of 2.2V to 5.5V.






Figure 1. Common-mode Rejection Ratio vs **Frequency**




Figure 2. Power-Supply Rejection Ratio vs Frequency




Figure 3. Quiescent Current vs Temperature




Figure 4. Input Bias Current vs Temperature




Figure 5. Small-Signal Step Response




Figure 6. Large-Signal Step Response






Figure 7. Negative Overvoltage Recovery

Figure 8. Positive Overvoltage Recovery




Figure 9. 0.1Hz to 10Hz Input Voltage Noise

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8 APPLICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION

Information in the following applications sections is not part of the RUNIC component specification, and RUNIC does not warrant its accuracy or completeness. RUNIC's customers are responsible for determining suitability of components for their purposes. Customers should validate and test their design implementation to confirm system functionality.

8.1 Application Notes

The RS6332P are high precision, rail-to-rail operational amplifiers that can be run from a single-supply voltage 2.2V to 5.5V (±1.1V to ±2.75V). Supply voltages higher than 7V (absolute maximum) can permanently damage the amplifier. Rail-to-rail input and output swing significantly increases dynamic range, especially in low-supply applications. Good layout practice mandates use of a 0.1uF capacitor place closely across the supply pins.

8.2 Layout Guidelins

Attention to good layout practices is always recommended. Keep traces short. When possible, use a PCB ground plane with surface-mount components placed as close to the device pins as possible. Place a 0.1uF capacitor closely across the supply pins. These guidelines should be applied throughout the analog circuit to improve performance and provide benefits such as reducing the EMI susceptibility.




Figure 10. Amplifier with Bypass Capacitors






Figure 11. Amplifier instrumentation amplifier







